

LONGSTANTON HATTONS CHARITY

Longstanton Hatton Charity was set up by the Charity Commissioners in 1898 for the benefit of deserving persons residing in the Village.

The Charity owns two pieces of land, one situated in Over and the other at Gravel Bridge.

The land had belonged to the Parish of Longstanton as far back as 1624 but formal tenancy agreements were only drawn up in 1975 although the land was leased to the existing tenants before this date.

The rental from these parcels of land is used to provide a modest monetary gift at Christmas for elderly residents of Longstanton. The criteria to receive this gift is that recipients should be over 70 years of age and have resided in the village for over 20 years.
