

Allotments for Public Stone, Gravel & Clay Pits (Gravel Pit)

Report for the Annual Parish Meeting 25th April 2016

This year has seen a little activity on behalf of the charity known as 'The Gravel Pit'.

The Parish Council had been advised that all land that they are responsible for should be registered with Land Registry. Therefore, solicitors are currently working on behalf of the charity to have the land registered.

In addition, it was found that the old bank who held the accounts, had not updated the new signatories from 2012 and both accounts had been placed into a dormant state. The Parish Council, as sole Trustee, has opened a new bank account specifically for this charity, and has instructed the old bank to transfer the money held, in the region of £1,100, to the new account.

The land continues to be abused by fly grazing, but it has been felt, by trustees that it is not beneficial to the charity, to use the limited funds in civil proceedings to have the horses removed.
