Application to divert part of Public Footpath No. 5, Longstanton

Cambridgeshire County Council has received an application to divert part of Footpath No. 5, Longstanton. The diversion is proposed under section 257 of the Town and County Planning Act 1990 to enable development to be carried out on the current route as part of the Northstowe Phase 1 scheme.

Please see the attached map for details. The definitive route of Footpath No. 5 runs from points A-B-C-D. The proposed route would run from Points E-F-G-H-I-J-D.

It is intended that a creation agreement subsequent to this diversion application would provide Public Bridleway status along this route.
